### **NOTES**

- 1.SJV receives significant income from parents participating in the ESA (Empowerment Scholarship Account) state program and various STO's (School Tuition Organizations). The most important source is CEA (Catholic Education Arizona) which receives individual and corporate tax credits from parishioners and friends of St. John Vianney.
- 2. By far our largest and most important expense is for our human resources, the wonderful parish staff and the school's faculty, staff and administration.
- 3. The significant administration expense in 2022 was due to the purchase of new technology for the school. These were paid for by federally designated funds for school technology.
- 4. We do not include depreciation in this report.
- 5. The 2022 deficit was paid by savings and the 2023 surplus placed in the parish savings fund. This savings fund (seen below in the statement of financial position) operates effectively as a "rainy day fund" and the seeds of future projects and initiatives.

- 6. The parish maintains an operating account for payroll and current expenses and invests any additional funds in short-term certificates of deposit.
- 7. Most of the parish's assets are the property, buildings and furnishings. These are valued at historical costs.
- 8. Together Let Us Go Forward is a Diocesan campaign and this amount is what we as a parish have received from the Diocese in order to complete designated projects in our parish.
- 9. Our Net Assets that are restricted have been designated by donors for specific projects and uses within the overall Mission of the Parish. Essentially, we "owe" this to be spent as the donors instructed us.

These financial statements are fair representations of our financial position and activity of St. John Vianney Parish and School as of June 30, 2023.
